



Housewarming Kits

Thank you for helping a refugee family by donating a Housewarming Kit. Upon arrival, each refugee and refugee family receives a Housewarming Kit when they move into their new home. These kits are filled with necessary housing supplies.

By providing these essential items to families, you are not only helping to create a warm welcome but you are making a difference in their lives as they begin their journey of resettlement. Additionally, these donated items help save families money. When LFSRM doesn't get these items donated we have to purchase them using funds that we would otherwise use for that family's deposit, rent, and utilities.

The following is a list of items that must be included in each kit. You can spend as little or as much as you want but the kits must contain all of the items on this list. Please place all items in the large waste basket. These items should be new/unopened and full-sized not travel or hotel sized. Please do not include any food items.

Required Items

- Broom & dustpan
- Large waste basket
- Small waste basket
- Tall trash bags
- Mop
- Laundry detergent
- Toilet brush w/ holder
- Dish Soap
- Shower curtain & hooks
- All purpose cleaner
- Toilet bowl cleaner
- 60W light bulb pack
- Paper towels

Optional Items

- Dish scrubbers/sponges
- Kitchen/dish towels
- Oven mitts
- Small trash bags
- Scissors
- Window cleaner
- Toilet plunger
- Reuseable shopping bags
- Home first aid kit
- Small home tool kit
- Gift Cards* (Target, CVS, Walmart or Walgreens)

**If you are including a gift card, please tape a note with the store name and amount to the outside lid of the container so we can explain to the recipient how and where they can use the card.*
