



Apartment Bin Checklist

Thank you for helping a refugee family by donating an apartment bin. Upon arrival, each refugee and refugee family receives the following basic items and goods. By providing these apartment bins for families, you are helping a family save money: when LFSRM doesn't get these items donated, we have to purchase them using funds that we would otherwise use for that family's deposit, rent, and utilities.

Please include only new items from places such as Wal-Mart, the Dollar Tree, Target, etc. Please do not include food items or any additional items that are not on this list. These items should all be placed in the large waste basket so we can easily deliver it to the family's home.

The following is a list of items that MUST be included in the apartment bin.
Each bin needs to include every item on the list.

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| ☐ Large waste basket | ☐ Paper towels |
| ☐ Small waste basket | ☐ 60W Light bulbs |
| ☐ Tall trash bags | ☐ All-purpose kitchen & bathroom cleaner |
| ☐ Mop | ☐ Cleanser (such as Ajax or Comet) |
| ☐ Dust pan and broom | ☐ Toilet paper (4 roll pack) |
| ☐ Mixing bowl set | ☐ Toilet brush w/ holder |
| ☐ Set of rubber/silicone spatulas | ☐ Shower curtain |
| ☐ Set of wooden spoons | ☐ Shower hooks |
| ☐ Set of kitchen utensils/serving spoons | ☐ Bar soap (2 pack) |
| ☐ Can opener | ☐ Men's deodorant |
| ☐ Set of knives | ☐ Women's deodorant |
| ☐ Dish soap | ☐ Toothbrushes (6 pack) |
| ☐ Laundry detergent | ☐ Toothpaste 3oz or more |
